BAC BIDS OUT BULK OF OFFICE SUPPLIES breaks tradition...

The City of Butuan through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) under the chairmanship of Ms. Leah A. Mendoza, City Administrator, breaks the tradition of negotiated bidding by initiating a synchronize procurement of **Php2,366,309.37** worth of office supplies for the various offices and departments of the City through open public bidding, a first in history of City's procurement of office supplies

Through this bold initiative, the City Government has saved thousands of pesos compared to previous mode of procurement. In turn, the amount saved thru this move will be turned-over to the City

through the General Fund to finance other priority projects of the City.

The members of the BAC who unanimously support this initiative are Ms. Gemma M. Reserva (Vice-Chairman, City General Services Officer CGSO), Atty. Anna Liza L. Gonzales (City Legal Officer), Ms. Maria Ruth N. Jugao (CEED Manager), Engr. Antenedo E. Milloren (City Planning and Development Coordinator), and BAC-TWG Pointperson, Cresencio A. Bermudez, Jr. of the City Legal Office.

This bulk procurement of office supplies through open bidding is designed not only to make savings

but also to instigate a conscientious use of government supplies to all City personnel. The Supply Officer of each department is also tasked to establish control on the releases of supplies until the completion and realization of the warehouse building to start a new and centralized procurement not only on office supplies but as well as construction materials, drugs and medicines, and other supplies.

Meanwhile, the BAC forecasts a regular bidding of office supplies based on the approved Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) for goods and infrastructures.
